LENTEN FAST AND ABSTINENCE: Catholics age 14 and over are obliged to abstain from meat on all Fridays of Lent. Catholics age 18 and not yet 59 should eat only one full meal on Good Friday. Otherwise, we are obliged to do unspecified penance which will be of spiritual value to us.

MARRIAGE VOW RENEWAL: At all the Masses on the weekend of February 13th & 14th, in honor of St. Valentins’s, married couples will be given a special blessing, asking God’s graces upon them and their families.

LENTEN SCHEDULE: During Lent there will be Mass each morning as usual, Monday - Friday at 8:10 A.M. Every Friday during Lent we will also have Stations of the Cross at 5:00 P.M.
