SOCIAL SPACING IN CHURCH IS REQUIRED. ONLY EVERY OTHER PEW MAY BE USED. THE USE OF PEWS MUST RESPECT SOCIAL DISTANCING. THIS MEANS THAT NO ONE IS TO SIT WITHIN 6 FEET OF ONE ANOTHER, UNLESS LIVING IN THE SAME HOUSEHOLD.
